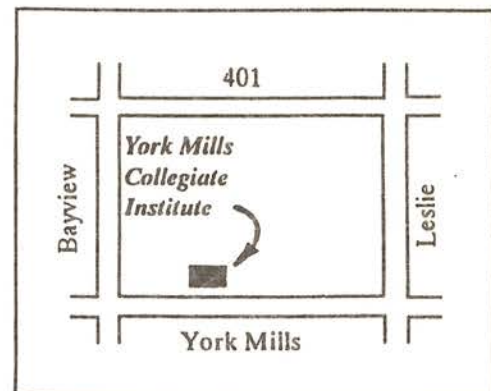

To further my concern, if a novice competitor's carving wins a first place while it is the only carving in the category, they must move to the intermediate class the next time they compete. This may not be a fair evaluation of that person's qualifications and could undermine the carver for any future competitive endeavors.

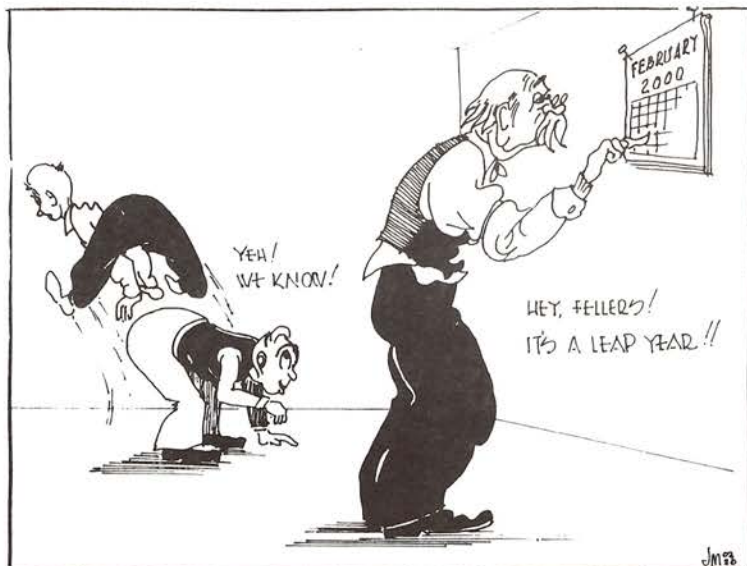
Quebec festival slated for September 8-9-10

The Handy Cover Plate

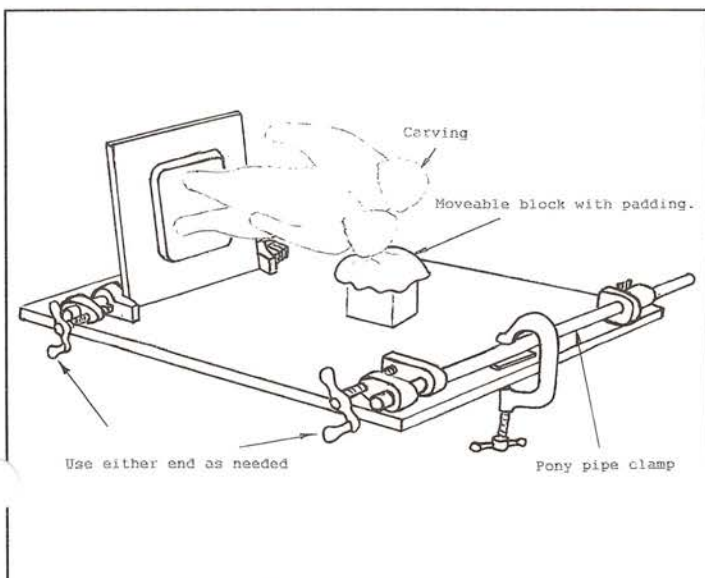
In November 1998 issue of the Ontario Woodcarver Newsletter I wrote about a way to produce a flat base for your carvings, and then advised you to place a cover plate over it. The cover plate is to protect the flat surface of course but it can be very useful in other ways.

Make the plate square and fairly robust. I suggest 3/4" plywood. It should be large enough to extend about 2" beyond the base of your carving. Fasten the plate to your carving with four screws making sure they will not penetrate the final surface of the carved base.

During rough carving, attach the plate directly to your bench with "C" clamps. Take care not to place too much stress on the screws. Remember, the sharper your tools, the less force is required to remove the wood.

After rough carving, you will need a little more flexibility with positioning to do the finish carving. This too is achieved by using your cover plate.

With the use of a flat surface and two Pony pipe-clamps, you will be able to easily adjust your carving to eight planes, tilting it to any angle (see sketch). This simple method holds your carving firmly in place, enabling you to carve with both hands. However, because of physical constraints, this method may be limited to carvings about 12" to 36" high by 3" to 12" square.
